Course Objectives

The report, including an abstract, must be suitably documented and illustrated, should be at least 1000 words in length, must be typewritten on one side of 21.5cm by 28cm white paper of quality, and must be enclosed in binding. Note that:

- You are required to attend at least four (4) presentations of your choice among the several presentations made in the department in connection with:
 - Invited seminars
 - Ph.D. thesis proposals
 - M.A.Sc. thesis defenses
 - Ph.D. seminars
- You have to get your attendance sheet signed by the faculty member who will be chairing the above mentioned sessions. You have to do it on the date of your attending the particular session.
- You should not ask for signature if you are attending any lecture/presentation other than the ones listed above. These do not count for your attendance or your report.
- You have to submit your report on any one of the several presentations attended by you. You will submit this to Dr. Aghdam (the coordinator). The **submission deadline** is: 4:00pm, Thursday April 15, 2010. You are encouraged to try to submit the report earlier.
