<p>Topic</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Appropriate system that has security considerations• Not a disallowed topic (proxies, etc) <p>Suitable in length</p>	2
<p>Core tasks and guidelines</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Description of core tasks that are actual prominent tasks a user would want to do• A description of who the target user is and what assumptions you make about them• Complete: there should be a balance between configuration and use. Thus, the core task list should not only include installation/configuration and security tasks are expected as well• Core tasks should have a security dimension to them• Guidelines can be from class but any modifications should be justified	3
<p>Walkthrough</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Evaluation should be detailed and clear.• It should be clearly stated if the guidelines are violated followed by a clear, technical, and step by step explanation.• General explanation of software in terms of each core task is not acceptable. An evaluation is required.• Evaluation needs to be performed based on the defined core task list and not some general functions of the tool.• Evaluation should not miss obvious violations and should follow all possible paths a reasonable user might take	5
