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Team evaluation score: The professor evaluates the term paper presentation for the team as a whole using the following criteria:

<i>Quality of presentation material</i>	5
<i>Amount of Information vs comparison</i>	5
<i>Amount of technical information/explanations</i>	5
<i>Quality of answers to questions</i>	3
<i>Oratory skills</i>	2

Individual peer evaluation score: In addition to these 20 marks, which are common and equal for all team members, each individual team member is evaluated individually for an additional 5 marks for his/her individual contribution to the team's presentation, based on a peer evaluation done by the students in the audience.

For each team presentation given by teams other than hers/his, every student in the audience has to fill in a peer evaluation report and submit it at the end of the presentation. All grading reports will then be used to compute the *Individual peer evaluation score* for each individual student. Note that any student failing to submit peer evaluation reports for other teams' presentations will incur loss of grades in his own *Individual peer evaluation score*.

Explanation of criteria:

Quality of presentation material: Quality of the slides used for the presentation or any other material used for the presentation.

Amount of information vs comparison: The project is about comparing programming languages. How much is the presentation enabling you to compare different programming languages?

Amount of technical information/explanations: How much details are given during the presentation that enables you to understand the technical aspects of the programming languages presented and their differences?

Quality of answer to questions: How clear were the answers given?

Oratory skills: How structured, clear, and generally enjoyable was the presentation?
