<u>Quality of presentation material</u>: Quality of the slides used for the presentation or any other material used for the presentation.

<u>Amount of information vs comparison</u>: The project is about comparing programming languages. How much is the presentation enabling you to compare different programming languages?

<u>Amount of technical information/explanations</u>: How much details are given during the presentation that enables you to understand the technical aspects of the programming languages presented and their differences?

Quality of answer to questions: How clear were the answers given?

Oratory skills: How structured, clear, and generally enjoyable was the presentation?
