Faculty Council approved a new Expectations of Originality form and process last March. The purpose of the Expectations of Originality form is to remind students of the requirement not to plagiarize and of their obligation to submit original work.

Students are required to fill out one copy of the form for each course, at the beginning of the semester, and submit it to their professor.

The student should write on the cover page of each assignment, lab report or project the statement

I certify that this submission is my original work and meets the Faculty's Expectations of Originality

and sign the statement, write the date and write his/her I.D. number.

For group work, the statement is

We certify that this submission is the original work of members of the group and meets the Faculty's Expectations of Originality.

All the students in the group should sign the statement with the date and their I.D. number.
