- Full-time is defined as taking at least 9 credits. All INDU courses are 4 credits, except for INDU 6990 which is 8 credits.
- Most students who do not take the specified courses in Year 1 Winter and Year 2 Summer 1 and Summer 2 will not be able to take the Year 2 2-term (Fall + Winter) capstone course (INDU 6990) and thus delay completion of their program by one year, effectively switching over to the Fall 2025 entry course sequence and being a few courses ahead of that sequence.
- Students who must take ENCS 6721 and/or ENCS 5721 as part of the Qualifying Program do not have to take the 1-credit course, and should replace that by a required ENCS course. If a second ENCS course is required that should be added in Summer 1 or Summer 2.
- Many MECH courses are reserved for MECH and AERO students and are not available for INDU students. Always select electives that are available to INDU students.
- Note that there is no course sequence for <u>I Engineering Management</u> as that requires students to have a full-time engineering job at a local company to do their two <u>industrial stages</u>, as required by the program. It is also the nature of the option that we can accept only very few students. International students are thus not accepted for the Engineering Management option.
