Examination procedure

- **Questions will be made available as a zip file on the course web site at the start of the examination**

1. **Unzip the zip file. It will create a folder named "COMP345.programmingexam"**
2. **The questions are in the "QuestionStatement" folder**
3. **Some questions come with code in the "QuestionCode" folder**
4. **Provide your answers in the "Answer/Code" folder**
5. **Provide only .cpp and .h files as answers**
6. **The code in this folder should be complete and compilable**
7. **If it does not compile, you will have major grade deductions**
8. **Write compilation instructions (mandatory) and notes to the marker (not necessary) in the INSTRUCTIONS.txt file**
9. **When you are finished, you should zip the entire "COMP345.programmingexam" folder and upload it to the EAS before the end of the examination period under "lab1"**
10. **You can submit any number of versions. Only the last one submitted during the scheduled examination time will be corrected**
